### Update re: Water Main Break

**UPDATE #3 (4:00 PM):** Due to unforeseen circumstances, the necessary scheduled repairs will be postponed until Monday, February 9, 2026. Therefore, water services will resume for residents in the following areas until repairs continue:

- Edward Street
- 6, 12, 18, & 20 Pitawanakwat Street
- Linda Street
- Wakegijig Avenue
- Peltiers Trail
- Daawema Road
- Hills Trail
- Spruce Street
- Wagosh Street
- Gabow Bend

Please continue to follow the Boil Water Advisory as previously instructed.

Community members can continue to pick up water this weekend from the WUT Public Works Garage. For those households that do not have the means to pick up water, please call or text 705-665-3082 to arrange for delivery. Please include your name and home address. Water pick-up and delivery will be available from 8:00am to 8:00pm daily until this is resolved.

Manitowaning water fill station at their Public Works Garage, on HWY 6 across the road from NAPA, is also available for community members to fill water jugs/containers.

We will provide further updates and information as they become available.

**UPDATE #2 (2:00 PM):** To complete the necessary repairs identified on Edward Street, Public Works will need to temporarily shut off water service to the surrounding neighbourhood.

Water is expected to be shut off from 3:00 PM to 9:00 PM this evening.

UPDATE #1 (10:30AM): We want to remind the community that the Boil Water Advisory still stands, and this affects all households in the village connected to the water distribution system. Rural households who received water delivery are not directly affected but are still being advised to conserve water—this is because water delivery is still suspended until the Boil Water Advisory is lifted.

The two water main breaks from yesterday were repaired early this morning, however we have discovered a third issue on Edward Street (near the Wikwemikong Tribal Police Services Station). The crew is currently working to repair this third issue.

With the third repair, the following locations will be affected and possibly the entire subdivision. We will provide updates as they become available.

- Edward Street
- 6 to 20 Pitawanakwat Street

**The Boil Water Advisory remains in effect for at least 48 hours after all issues and repairs are addressed.**
