

# WIKWEMIKONG UNCEDED TERRITORY

## Request to Receive a Mail-In Ballot

Wikwemikong Unceded Territory is now under the First Nations Elections Act (FNEA) in the electing of Chief and Councillors. Under FNEA off-reserve voters are not automatically mailed a ballot package, each individual voter must complete a form requesting a mail-in ballot be mailed to them

Any elector may vote by mail-in ballot by submitting a *Request for Mail-in Ballot* form, which can be obtained from the electoral officer, along with a copy of identification. Last day to receive ballot requests is Friday, August 14, 2026. A ballot request form was included in the initial mail-out notifying off-reserve voters about the Notice of Nomination Meeting.

If you are voting in-person at the Council Chambers on August 15<sup>th</sup> or 22<sup>nd</sup> you do not need to complete a ballot request form, bring photo ID.

Nomination Meeting:	Sat, July 11, 2026 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.
Advance Poll:	Sat, Aug 15, 2026 9:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
Election Day:	Sat, Aug 22, 2026 9:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
